Do you have the confidence and skills to effectively support young LGBTIQ carers? Our new online resource can help you provide inclusive and appropriate services for young carers who are lesbian, gay, bisexual, intersex, trans/gender diverse, queer and/or questioning.

Young LGBTIQ carers are not always recognised or well understood by services and there is little research about their specific needs. This eLearning program was developed with young people and workers across Victoria. It builds on young carer stories and current inclusive practice knowledge to better support you in your work.
