

There are 2.65 million carers in Australia - 1 in 10 Australians






221,300 Victorian primary carers provide the most assistance to another person

11% of Australians in the workforce are carers



36% of Australia's primary carers have been caring for more than a decade





647,000 Australian carers are aged over 65 - more than 6 times the capacity of the MCG

The cost of replacing unpaid care is estimated at \$77.9 billion annually



1 in 10 carers are under 25, with 235,300 young carers Australia-wide





70% of Victorian primary carers are female with 400,500 women and girls having caring responsibilities
