The Victorian State election is on **Saturday 26 November 2022**.

At the Victorian Electoral Commission (VEC), we can help you:

- enrol or update your details on the electoral roll
- understand how government works in Victoria
- learn how to vote correctly.

2022 State election

The election is on **Saturday 26 November 2022**.

You must enrol to vote by **Tuesday 8 November 2022** if you:

- are an Australian citizen
- are 18 or older and
- have lived in Victoria for longer than a month.

You must enrol within 21 days of becoming eligible to vote in Victoria.

If you have moved house or changed your name recently you must update your details.
