The Bridge to Rights project strives to empower young people with an NDIS plan from various culturally diverse backgrounds and Vietnamese carers.

Safe Space Hub - Springvale

Safe Space Hub Springvale provides a supportive environment for personalised guidance with exercising NDIS rights, identifying and accessing support and the development of self-advocacy skills.

Safe Space Hub Springvale will offer monthly in person and phone sessions (by appointment) facilitated by bilingual (Vietnamese and English) staff who are knowledgeable about the NDIS. Safe-Space Hub appointments focus on addressing individual concerns that may not be covered in group or other formal settings through advice and referral.

Program Eligibility:

understanding of NDIS rights and equipping you with the confidence and skills to exercise these rights, we aim to foster independence, self-advocacy, and stronger community connections.

• Vietnamese carers, and youth aged 16-25 years of all culturally and linguistically diverse backgrounds with an NDIS plan

Schedule and Locations:

- Monthly, by a 20-minute appointment, **between 10 am 1 pm** on the **first Wednesday** of a month.
