A carer is a family member or friend who provides support to someone with a disability, mental health condition including substance overuse, chronic illness including palliative care and aged - related needs.

A carer could be a child, adult child, parent, sibling, grandparent, friend or neighbour.

### **Purpose**

This guide is for people working directly in carer support services or indirectly with carers, i.e. through their work with clients in the health, disability, aged, mental health or education sectors. It is intended this resource will help workers connect carers effectively to services and benefits that support them in their caring role.

This guide is not designed to be given to carers directly.

#### How to Use this Guide

A bit of context...carers are time poor and spend many hours trying to find services they need for themselves, and the person they support. Sometimes carers receive referrals for services for which they are ineligible or have long waiting lists. This can lead to disappointment and frustration.

Before encouraging a carer to contact a support or when making a referral on their behalf, we encourage you to be familiar with the following:

- the current supports provided by the organisation
- the eligibility requirements
- registration processes and requirements, e.g. evidence about the person they support
- waiting time for the service.
